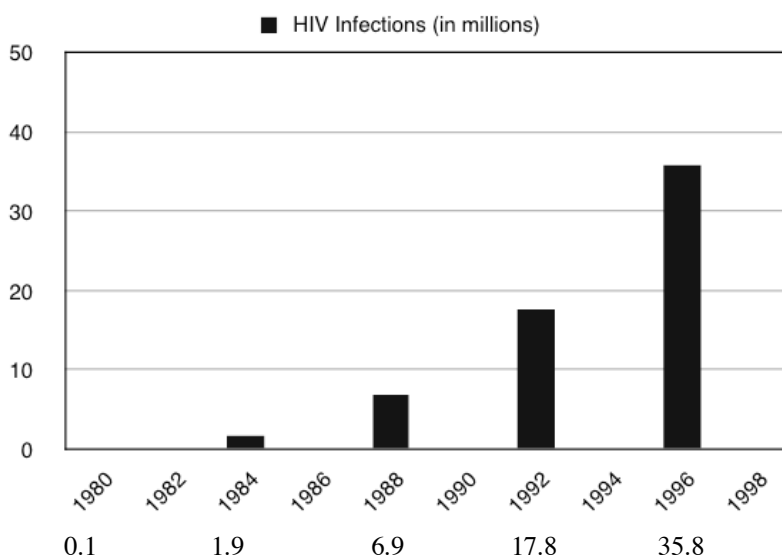

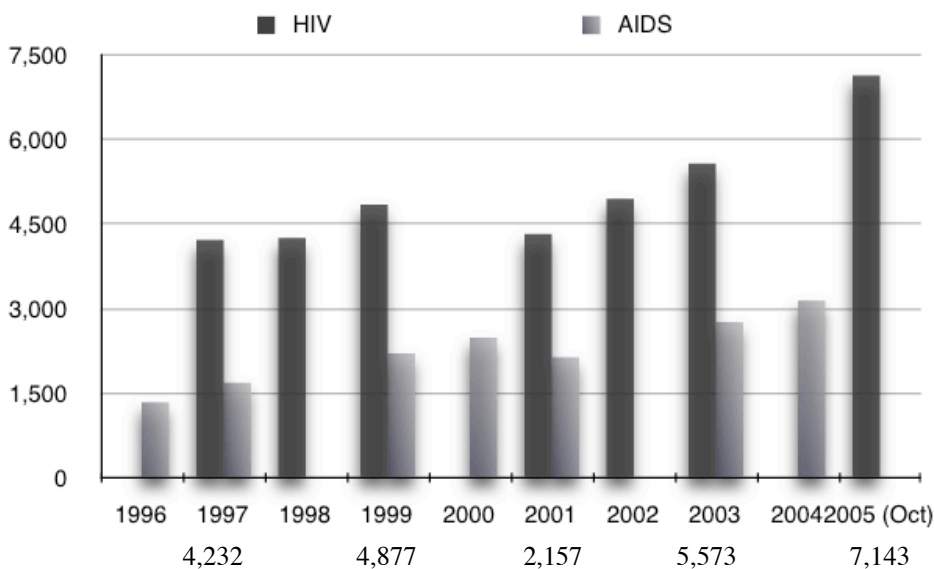
- In Zimbabwe, how many people die every day from AIDS?

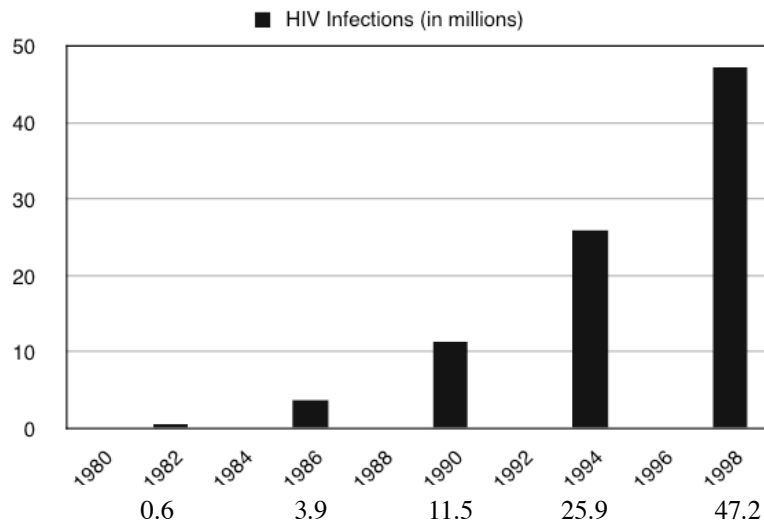

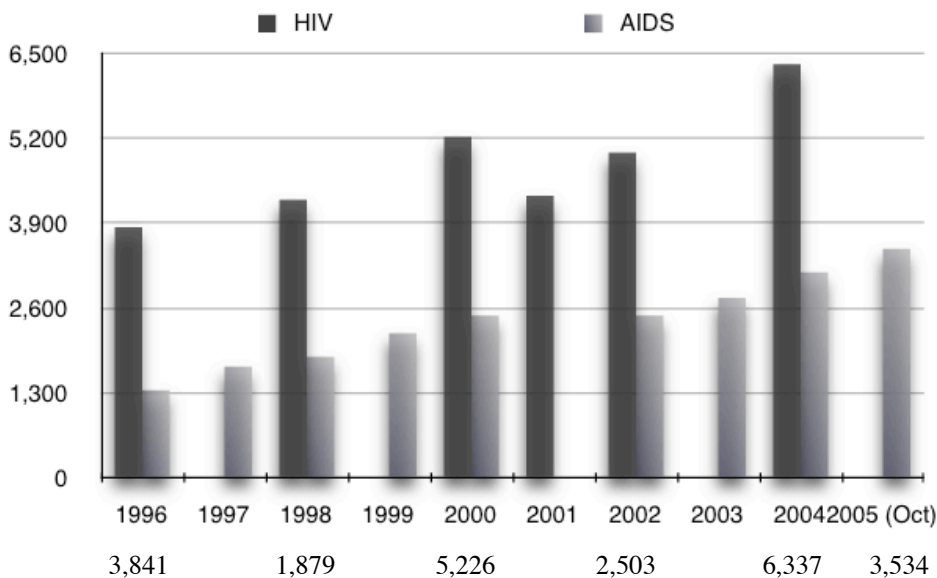
- What percentage of people in sub-Saharan Africa with AIDS are women?
